Main route for a pilgrimage to the Kumano Sanzan Shrines Kumano Kaido (Road)



The Shindachi area long served as a posting town on Kumano Kaido for old pilgrimages to the three Kumano Grand Shrines, presently a World Heritage site, and for daimyos' (feudal lords) trips with many attendants in the Edo period (17th-19th century). You can see many historical sites, including old temples and inns, in this area.
